The Basilica of Santa Sabina was built in Rome in the year 432. Overlooking the Tiber River and two blocks away from the ruins of the Roman Circus Maximus, it was given to St. Dominic, founder of the Order of Preachers, in 1220 by Pope Honorius III. The Order had been in existence for four years and was in the

infancy of its mission of doctrinal preaching “For the Salvation of Souls”. Santa Sabina became the home of St. Dominic and the world headquarters of the Dominican Friars.

Lining the main hallway are 88 portraits of each Friar who served as the Master of the Order, an unbroken chain of 88 men starting with St. Dominic in 1216 and ending with the portrait of the current Master of the Order, Fr. Gerard Timoner III, OP. Although most Friars, Nuns and Sisters who follow in the footsteps of St. Dominic will never visit Santa Sabina, it is a spiritual home in the hearts of all Dominicans.

The portraits remind us of the graces received by the Order over the centuries. They remind us of the hunger of the brothers and sisters for souls to know and love God. Many of the Dominican saints are well known in the Church: St. Dominic, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Catherine of Siena, St. Martin De Porres, St. Rose of Lima, The Martyrs of Vietnam, Blessed Giovanni Fiesole (Fra Angelico) and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. Some of them are less so: St. Albert the Great, St. John of Cologne, St. Juan Macias, and St. Lorenzo Ruiz and Companions.

The portraits at Santa Sabina remind Dominicans of their enduring mission to preach the Gospel of Jesus and to witness Christian charity through the vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. As Blessed Humbert of Romans said, “The Word of God is intoxicating.” Knowing and loving God is the highest calling of human life. But this love is not exclusive. When one truly loves God, there cannot but be an accompanying love of souls who are made in the image and likeness of God. In the Dominican spiritual life, the encounter with God in prayer and study is incomplete if one is not further compelled to share the fruits of these activities with others.

Is a tradition in the parishes staffed by the Dominican Friars to celebrate the Solemnity of St. Dominic (August 8) on the nearest Sunday in August so that the parish may also join in the celebration of St. Dominic. For the past 48 years the parishioners of Holy Family Cathedral have traveled the way of St. Dominic with the Friars who have served here. Together, our community has preached and lived the Gospel of Jesus, bringing our Lord’s message of hope, faith and charity to Anchorage and the state of Alaska.

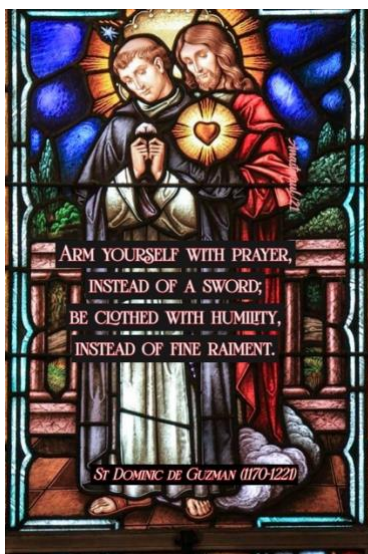

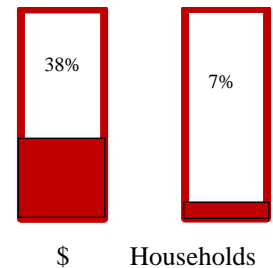
