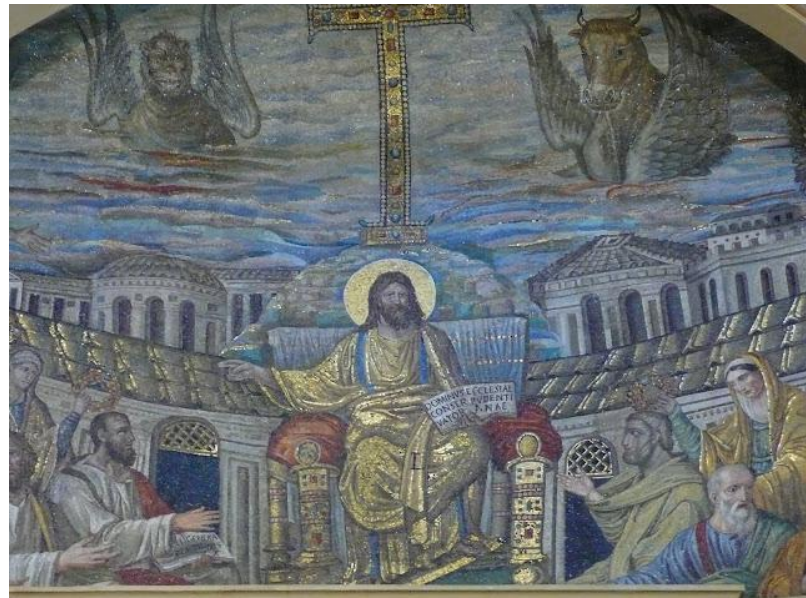

VICAR'S COLUMN - Easter V

“The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone” (from Psalm 118:22) is one of the most memorable and often quoted lines in sacred scripture. It is brief and forceful. For someone to be considered a throwaway item is a perfect set for an underdog story. It is a sign that the darkness of this world can be overcome and shatter worldly expectations. Almost all of us have moments in our lives where we experience being thrown away and rejected. Even if that experience is more perceptual than actual, we all find ourselves in a world that we did not choose and often with unideal circumstances. In all this we can still learn more than just about the rejection of Christ. In the second reading for Mass today St. Peter prefaces his use of Psalm 118 by telling his readers “Come to him, a living stone, rejected by human beings, but chosen and precious in the sight of God let yourselves be built into a spiritual house.” The Church is built upon the rejected and upon all our moments of rejection. Through our trials and wounds, God forms us into living stones, precious in his sight.

It is very easy in our moments of failure and trial to feel rejected by God. However, these are moments where we should turn to prayer to reflect on how God is forming us because that is precisely what He is doing!

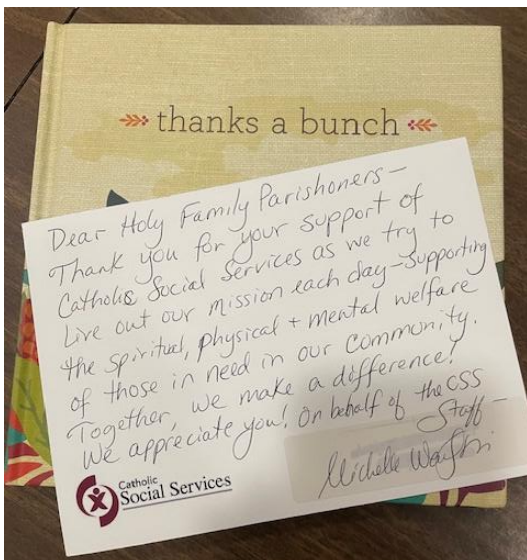
